PROTECTING OUR PARTNERS


Each of our international partners have a code of conduct that includes social media policies and guidelines. After traveling and building relationships with children and staff during your week of international service, it might seem normal to add your new friends on social media in an effort to stay connected. However, we are often unaware that what we post can negatively impact our partners and the ministry that we initially set out to serve. To minimize this impact, we ask that you refrain from adding any of the youth that you interact with while serving with HFK on your socials. Please refer to your partner site's specific code of conduct for more details about their social media policy to keep the community you are serving safe.

SHARING YOUR EXPERIENCE

Social media is a great way to share your experience with your loved ones and spread the mission of HFK. Get creative! Make a video of your experience, design a meme, create a slideshow of your trip, etc. Be respectful yet open when sharing your HFK memories. Keep site specific codes of conduct in mind when creating posts that include children.
